Important Information

1. English Requirement Information

You may be required to fulfill the English proficiency requirement set by the Malaysian Ministry of Higher Education prior to enrollment. Universiti Islam Malaysia recognises a number of English language assessments as meeting the University's English language requirements. Accepted English language assessments and the minimum results required are detailed in **Diploma** or **Degree** link.

If you have not fulfilled the English requirement, you are required to sit for an English Placement test (EPT) before class commencement to assess the level of your English proficiency. This is required for students who are enrolling in UIM's Intensive English Programme (IEP)/Academic English Programme (AEP).

2. **Fee Information**

Indicative tuition fees has been stated. Fees are reviewed annually and are subject to change. Tuition fees are calculated per teaching session and the amount will be based on your enrolment at the time of invoicing for that session only.

International students are required to pay a sum of RM2000/- being the "Advance Fee", or the total fees payable, whichever is higher. This fee shall be used as payment of the student's first and following semester tuition fees (where applicable).

Please read through the <u>Student Fees and Charges Policy</u> carefully and acknowledge that you have read and fully understand the terms and conditions, including the consequences and actions that can be taken by UIM in the event of non-compliance.

3. **Enrollment Information**

You are required to submit the certified true copy of your certificates and academic transcripts prior to your enrolment into the aforementioned programme. Failure to submit your official results before registration or failure to meet the entry requirements and any other academic requirements of the aforementioned programme shall invalidate this offer.

General Education Subjects

For local and international students, it is a requirement of the Malaysian Qualifications Agency that you pass all the required General Education Subjects (Mata Pelajaran Umum or MPU) prior to your graduation.

For local students, if you did not sit for SPM or fail to obtain a credit for Bahasa Malaysia during your SPM, you will be required to enroll for the Bahasa Kebangsaan A (MPU).

4. Orientation Programme Information

An orientation programme has been organized to help you familiarise yourself with the campus facilities and environment. It is a vital part of preparing you for life at UIM.

6. **Medical Examination Information**

6.1 Local student

You are required to undergo medical examination and submit the medical examination report

6.2 International student

Following the requirements of the Malaysian Ministry of Higher Education, international students are required to undergo a full medical examination within 7 days of their arrival in Malaysia.

This examination can be conducted at any of the panel of clinics appointed by Education Malaysia Global Services (EMGS).

Should any concerns arise from the medical examination that are not in line with Malaysian health requirements, you may be required to leave the country.
